RESOLUTION OF THE ALTO SANITARY DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Members of the Board of Directors ("Board") of the Alto Sanitary District ("District") previously adopted a conflict of interest code through Resolution 02-04, as amended through Resolution 2014-03 ("Prior Conflict of Interest Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to update and amend such Prior Conflict of Interest Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Political Reform Act (Government Code Sections 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations ("FPPC Regulations"), Section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code. The District hereby adopts the terms of that standard conflict-of-interest code, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission (together, "Section 18730"), and incorporates them herein by reference. As a result, Section 18730 and the attached Appendices, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the District ("Conflict of Interest Code").
- All Individual Filers (as defined in Appendix A) shall file (via electronic or other means) with the Elections Department of the County of Marin a State of Economic Interest providing the information required by the relevant Disclosure Category identified in Appendix B. Statements of Economic Interest shall be made on forms prescribed by the FPPC, and shall contain the information required by FPPC Regulations Section 18730.
