RESOLUTION 2021-02

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE APPROPRIATION LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 AND THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBJECT TO LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22

WHEREAS, the people of California on November 6, 1979, added Article XIII-B to the State Constitution placing various limitations on the appropriation of the State and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature adopted Chapters 1205 and 1342 of the 1980 Statutes which implemented Article XIII-B; and

WHEREAS, the people of California on June 5, 1990 amended Article XIII-B effective July 1, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the amendments have been interpreted by a coalition of statewide organizations, and organizations have issued through the League of California Cities revised guidelines to recalculate the appropriations limit; and

WHEREAS, the Government Code provides the process in which to calculate the appropriations limit and requires local governments to adopt a resolution setting the annual appropriation limit; and

WHEREAS, the Alto Sanitary District has complied with the provisions of Article XIII-B in determining the appropriations limits for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Alto Sanitary District, Marin County, California that:

- 1. The annual adjustment factors used to calculate the FY 2021-22 appropriations limit shall be the Per Capita Personal Income change over prior year of 5.73% and the Population change over prior year of -0.47%.
- 2. The FY 2021-22 appropriation limit shall be \$156,068.
- 3. The FY 2021-22 final appropriations subject to the appropriation limit is \$90,123.
